



## Rural Revitalization, a Key to European Competitiveness

Due to insufficient employment and career perspectives, millions of Europeans have over the past 10 years left their home country and migrated to economically more prosperous EU areas. On top of this, there is a strong pressure from outside migrants and refugees who would like to enter Europe.

But.... is migration the only way to fulfill or match job opportunities and share economic development?

No, Refival proposes a fully feasible alternative by relocating certain tasks via Internet. With currently more than 150 million EU jobs being services related, every percent of tasks that can be packaged as Internet based jobs means a potential of 1,5 million people to be freely located geographically.

Deprived areas can thus share in the success of flourishing ones by moving tasks to them. The advantage is threefold: it optimizes the EU position from a global competitive perspective, it generates solidarity between European citizens and finally it gives people more freedom on where to live.
